Fine Arts explores traditional and contemporary ideas, materials, techniques, and criticality in relation to students' own ideas and creativity. At the end of each Semester, students stage formal assessment exhibitions within their studio space. These displays provide opportunities for showcasing work to the public and are essential for resolving existing ideas and considering new directions.
