## Postgraduate Diploma in Creative Arts Therapy

The Postgraduate Diploma in Creative Arts Therapy offers an introduction to the foundational philosophy, theories, and practices relating to the Creative Arts Therapy, and focuses on developing skills relevant to the workplace.

This programme is highly innovative and combines creativity and compassion to enhance well-being. There is a strong focus on developing confidence to strengthen practice, which considers a range of factors such as context, presenting problems, and appropriate arts modalities. The programme also supports culturally sensitive practices informed by the Māori worldview as well as other cultures. The Postgraduate Diploma in Creative Arts Therapy implements a blended learning structure, and includes a combination of topics including creative studio, social aspects of creative arts therapy, psychology of creative arts therapy, and group creative arts therapy.
